(in this order called "the authority") in pursuance of the powers conferred in that behalf by Section 29 of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1962, and subject to the provisions of Section 15 of the Forestry Act, 1967, hereby make the following Order:-

1. In this Order:—
"the Act" means the Town and Country Planning Act, 1962;
"owner" means the owner in fee simple, either in possession or who has granted a lease or tenancy of which the unexpired portion is less than three years; lessee (including a sub-lessee) or tenant in possession, the unexpired portion of whose lease or tenancy is three years or more and a mortgagee in possession; and "the Minister of Housing and Local Government/Secretary of State for Wales."

2.—Subject to the provisions of this Order and to the exemptions specified in the Second Schedulo hereto, no person shall, except with the consent of the authority and in accordance with the conditions, if any, imposed on such consent, cut down, top, lop, or wilfully destroy or cause or permit the cutting down, topping, lopping or wilful destruction of any tree specified in the First Schedule hereto er comprised in a group of trees or in a woodland therein specified, the position of which trees, groups of trees and woodlands is defined in the manner indicated in the said First Schedule [on the map annexed hereto] [on the map marked

-rigned by the Clerk of the Authority and deposited for inspection at offices of the authority at--a certified copy of which has been similarly deposited at <del>-] [and-</del> which map shall, for the purpose of such definition as aforesaid, prevail where any ambiguity arises between it and the specification in the said First Schedule.

- 3.—An application for consent made [to the authority]† under article 2 of this Order shall be in writing stating the reasons for making the application, and shall by reference if necessary to a plan specify the trees to which the application relates, and the operations for the carrying out of which consent is required.
- 4.—(1) Where an application for consent is made [to the authority]\* under this Order, the authority may grant such consent either unconditionally, or subject to such conditions (including conditions requiring the replacement of any tree by one or more trees on the site or in the immediate vicinity thereof), as the authority may think fit, or may refuse consent.

Provided that where the application relates to any woodland specified in the First Schedule to this Order the authority shall grant consent so for as accords with the principles of good forestry, except where, in the opinion of the authority, it is necessary in the interests of amenity to maintain the special character of the woodland or the woodland character of the area, and shall not impose conditions on such consent requiring replacement or replanting.

- (2) The authority shall keep a register of all applications for consent under this Order containing information as to the nature of the application, the decision of the authority thereon, any compensation awarded in consequence of such decision and any directions as to replanting of woodlands; and every such register shall be available for inspection by the public at all reasonable Lours.
- 5.—Where the authority refuse consent under this Order or grant such consent subject to conditions they may when refusing or granting consent certify in respect of any trees for which they are so refusing or granting consent that they are satisfied —
  - (a) that the refusal or condition is in the interests of good forestry; or
  - (b) in the case of trees other than trees comprised in woodlands, that the trees have an outstanding or special amenity value.
- 6.—(1) Where consent is granted under this Order to fell any part of a woodland other than consent for silvicultural thinning then unless -
  - (a) such consent is granted for the purpose of enabling development to be carried out in accordance with a permission to develop land under Part III of the Act, or
- (b) the authority with the approval of the Minister dispense with repleating,

the authority shall give to the owner of the land on which that part of the woodland is situated a direction in writing specifying the manner in which and the time within which he shall replant such land and where such a direction is given and the part is felled the owner shall, subject to the provisions of this Order, replant the said land in accordance with the direction.


- (2) Any direction given under paragraph (1) of this Article may include requirements as to --
  - (a) species;
  - (b) number of trees per acre;
  - (c) the erection and maintenance of fencing necessary for protection of the replanting;
  - (d) the preparation of ground, draining, removal of brushwood, lop and top; and
  - (e) protective measures against fire.
- 7.—On imposing any condition requiring the replacement of any tree under Article 4 of the Order, or on giving a direction under Article 6 of this Order with respect to the replanting of woodlands, the authority shall if such condition or direction relates to land in respect of which byelaws made by a river authority or a drainage board restrict or regulate the planting of trees, notify the applicant or the owner of the land, as the case may be, of the existence of such byelaws and that any such condition or direction has effect subject to the requirements of the river authority or drainage board under those byelaws and the condition or direction shall have effect accordingly.
- 3.—The provisions set out in the Third Schedule to this Order, being provisions of Part III of the Act adapted and modified for the purposes of this Order, shall apply in relation thereto.
- 9.—Subject to the provisions of this Order, any person who has suffered/damage or has incurred expenditure in consequence of any refusal of consent under this Order or of any grant of any such consent subject to conditions, shall, if he makes a claim on the authority within the time and in the manner prescribed by this Order, be entitled to recover from the authority compensation in respect of such damage or expenditure.

Provided that no compensation shall be payable in respect of a suffered or expenditure.

-incurred by reason of such refusal or grant of consent in the case of any trees the subject of a certificate in accordance with Article 5 of this Order.

- 10.—In assessing compensation payable under the last preceding Article account shall be taken of:
  - (a) any compensation or contribution which has been paid whether to the claimant or any other person, in respect of the same trees under the terms of this or any other Tree Preservation Order under Section 29 of the Act or under the terms of any Interim Preservation Order made under Section 8 of the Town and Country Planning (Interim Development) Act, 1943, or any compensation which has been paid or which could have been claimed under any provision relating to the preservation of trees or protection of woodlands contained in an operative scheme under the Town and Country Planning Act, 1932, and
  - (b) any injurious affection to any land of the owner which would result from the felling of the trees the subject of the claim.
- 11.—(1) A claim for compensation under this Order shall be in writing and shall be made by serving it on the authority, such service to be effected by delivering the claim at the offices of the authority addressed to the Clerk thereof or by sending it by prepaid post so addressed.
- (2) The time within which any such claim shall be made as aforesaid shall be a period of twelve months from the date of the decision of the authority, or of the Minister, as the case may be, or where an appeal has been made to the Minister against the decision of the authority, from the date of the decision of the Minister on the appeal.
- 12.—Any question of disputed compensation shall be determined in accordance with the provisions of Section 128 of the Act.
- 13.—Any person contravening the provisions of this Order is guilty of an offence under subsection (1) of Section 62 of the Act and liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding lifty pounds; and if in the case of a continuing offence the contravention is continued after conviction he is guilty of a further offence thereunder and liable on summary conviction to an additional line not exceeding forty shillings for every day on which the contravention is so continued.
- lh. -The provisions of Section 16 of the Civic Associtios Act, 1967 shall apply to this Order, and the Order shall take effect provisionally on the 7th Expanded 1868
- 15. -This Order say be cited as the County of East Sussem (Plashet Wood, Guestling) Tree Preservation Order, 1968.

## THIRD SCHEDULE

Provisions of the following parts of Part III of the Act as adapted and modified to apply to this Order.

- 22. Reference of applications to the Minister.—(1) The Minister may give directions to the authority requiring applications for consent under the Order to be referred to him instead of being dealt with by the authority.
- (2) A direction under this section may relate either to a particular application or to applications of a class specified in the direction.
- (3) Any application in respect of which a direction under this section has effect shall be referred to the Minister
- (4) Where an application for consent under the Order is referred to the Minister under this section, the provisions of Articles 4 and 5 of the Order shall apply as they apply to an application which falls to be determined by the authority.
- (5) Defore determining an application referred to him under this section the Minister shall, if either the applicant or the authority so desire, afford to each of them an opportunity of appearing before, and being heard by, a person appointed by the Minister for the purpose.
  - (f) The decision of the Minister on any application referred to him under this section shall be final,
- 22. - (2) A notice under this section shall be served in writing within twenty-light days from the receipt of notification of the decision, certificate or direction, as the case may 12, or such longer period as the Minister may allow.

- (5) Before determining at appeal under this section, the Minister shall, if either the appellant or the authority co desire, afford to each of them an opportunity of appearing before, and being heard by, a person appointed by the Minister
  - (7) The decision of the Minister on any appeal under this section shall be final.
- 24. Appeal in default of decision.—Where an application for consent under the Order is made to the authority, then unless within two months from the data of receipt of the application, or within such extended period as may at any time be agreed upon in writing between the applicant and the authority, the authority either—
  - (a) give notice to the applicant of their decision on the application; or
  - (b) give notice to him that the application has been referred to the Minister in accordance with directions given under section 22 of the Act;

the provisions of the last preceding section shall apply in relation to the application as if the consent to which it relates had been received by the authority, and as if notification of their decision had been received by the applicant at the end of the said period of two months, or at the end of the said extended period, as the case may be.

- 27. Power to revoke or modify the consent under the order.—(1) If it appears to the authority that it is expedient to revoke or modify any consent under the Order granted on an application made under Article 3 of the Order, the authority may by Order revoke or modify the consent to such extent as they consider expedient.
- (2) An Order under this section shall not take effect unless it is confirmed by the Minister; and the Minister may confirm any such Order submitted to him either without modification or subject to such modifications as he considers
- (3) Where an authority submit an Order to the Minister for his confirmation under this section, the authority shall furnish the Minister with a statement of their reason for making the Order and shall serve notice on the owner of the land affected, and on any other person who in their opinion will be affected by the Order, and if within the period of twenty-eight days from the service thereof any person on whom the notice is served so requires, the Minister, before confirming the Order, shall afford to that person, and to the authority, an opportunity of appearing before, and being heard by, a person appointed by the Minister for the purpose.
- (4) The power conferred by this section to revoke or modify a consent may be exercised at any time before the operations for which consent has been given have been completed.

Provided that the revocation or modification of consent shall not affect so much of those operations as has been previously carried out.

(5) Where a notice has been served in accordance with the provisions of subsection (3) of this section, no operations of the Minister under subsection (2) of this section.
