DVLA Driving Licence Check via the www.gov.uk on-line service

Please complete this check no earlier than 3 days before your appointment with the licensing officer (the check code is only valid for 21 days). You can't use this on-line service if your licence was issued outside of England, Wales or Scotland. Please contact the licensing team 01424 787550.

If you do not have internet access there are computer terminals in the Council's reception area (no printing facility). Please arrive early before your appointment so you can generate your code before meeting the licensing officer.

We need to check your DVLA driving licence details to see which vehicles you are entitled to drive and if you have any penalty points or convictions. Please follow these instructions; you will need your driving licence number, your National Insurance number, the postcode on your driving licence:
