### Request/Response

1. How many items of public rescue equipment (ie Lifebuoys, Lifebelts, Throw Lines or similar) does Rother District Council maintain at inland or coastal water sites. Excludes Swimming Pools

Bexhill (Galley Hill - Normans Bay): 60 life rings  
Camber (Jury's Gap - Cliff End, Pett): 24 life rings

To note: These life rings are the only type of PRE we have on RDC beaches

2. What is the inspection routine for such items?

The standard operating procedure for inspecting the PRE is to carry out daily checks throughout Peak Season (May-September) and weekly checks thereafter (October – April).

3. Who should the public contact to report items missing or damaged?

The relevant Coastal Officer should be contacted for the particular beach.
