



**OSTRICH FARMS
SCHEDULE OF ADDITIONAL LICENCE CONDITIONS
FOR DANGEROUS WILD ANIMALS
DANGEROUS WILD ANIMALS ACT 1976**

1. The Rother District Council must be provided with an up-to-date site plan and detailed layout plan of the area devoted to ostrich farming.
2. The detailed plan(s) should show clearly the position of access roads and footways, perimeter and safety fences, rearing pens, catch pens, breeding facilities and isolation facilities.
3. The detailed plan should detail the following requirements:-
 - a) Breeding Paddocks – These are to be fenced with plain 8 or 10 gauge wire which is to be at least 2 metres high with strands approximately 225mm apart. The bottom strand must be at least 450mm off the ground.
 - b) Rearing Pens – Areas enclosing birds up to 6 months old should be enclosed with 1.2 m chicken or pig wire and 2 plain wire strands 225mm apart above this. The mesh must touch the ground, but it is recommended that the wire is buried 150mm under the ground to prevent predators gaining access to the pens.
 - c) Details of foot and vehicular access and the position of all gates must be clearly shown on the detailed plan.
