REMOVAL OF PUBLIC PAYPHONE SERVICE:

I am writing to advise you that BT Payphones has received a request from Rye town council , who want to adopt 2 BT telephone kiosks , their addresses are ‘Cinque ports Rye.TN31 7AN’ and ‘The Strand , Rye.TN31 7AN.’

Before we can remove a kiosk we have an obligation to consult with relevant public bodies on the proposed removal. As part of the consultation process it is a requirement that the Council reply in writing to BT within 90-days giving their comments or any objections received from the local community.
