


Proposed Equipped Areas of Play



Proposed Pathways

- 1. Landscape corridor and 'buffer' to northern boundary. To include stand off to conserved tree/ hedgerow and new native trees and planting to reinforce the boundary where required. Open wetland swale and conservation grassland included.
- 2. Public open space and sustainable drainage and mixed habitats.
- 3. Large public open space and multi-use Green Infrastructure to include sustainable drainage ponds, conservation grassland, wetland habitats and native tree and scrub planting. Also to include footpaths and play facility.
- 4. Large conserved oak trees set within broad open space. Proposed additional oak trees and conservation grassland. Incidental seating / meeting spaces included.
- 5. Conserved and proposed 'buffer' planting to property
- . Proposed native woodland and tree / scrub planting alongside Broad Oak Park boundary. To enhance existing trees / planting and to include semi-mature trees stock.
- . New dwellings set back and positively fronting towards conserved trees and public open space.
- 8. Existing mature trees and planting to park boundary form effective buffer and visual screen / filter.
- 9. Broad Oak Park and public footpaths. Existing views towards housing to the north east, south east and
- 10.Proposed native tree and scrub planting towards boundary with Broad Oak Park. Additional hedgerow infill planting also included.
- 11. Proposed 'buffer' planting to property boundaries.
 12. Conserved and enhanced boundary hedgerow and tree planting on rising ground above new dwellings.
