Quote from Ben Hooks email to my enquiry:-

"Dear Chris,

Please find attached the s.106 agreement related to this site (or s.52 as it would have been known in 1976 when it was signed). An interesting read to say the least. The agreement predates the two applications you have outlined below, although some of the documentation in the attached does relate to RR/80/2192.

This s.52 relates to the original development of the land and restricts development in the lands hatched in Brown and Blue without the consent of the Council under seal. This is different to the award of a planning permission and an example of this can be seen later in the document in which the Council gave permission to release the covenant in regards to the land hatched red for the purposes of the RR/80/2192 application and subsequent development.

The remaining lands would need a covenant release by the Council prior to development taking place. It is unlikely that the Council would unreasonably withhold such permission if there were a planning permission granted through our function as the local planning authority.
