38/0185/91 TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING GENERAL DEVELOPMENT ORDER, 1950.

WEEREAS the County Council for the Administrative County of East Sussex being the local planning authority for the Borough of Rye are satisfied that it is expedient that development of the description specified in the Schedule hereto should not be undertaken within the area of the said Borough as is bounded by the red line marked on the map attached hereto unless permission therefor is granted on application duly made in that behalf under the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1950.

MOW THEREFORE the said County Council in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1950 HEREBY DIRECT that the permission granted by Article 3 of the said Order shall not apply in the area of the Borough of Rye as above defined to levelopment of the description set out in the Schedule hereto

THE SCHEDULE.

- (1) The enlargement, improvement or other alteration of a dwellinghouse; the erection of a garage, stable, loosebox, or coach-house within the curtilage of the dwellinghouse shall be treated as the enlargement of the dwellinghouse for the purposes of this Direction.
- (2) The painting of the exterior of any building.
