
Town & Country Planning General Development Order, 1950

WHEREAS the County Planning Committee of the County Council of East Sussex, acting on behalf of the County Council as the Local Planning Authority for the said County, are satisfied that it is expedient that the development specified in Part I of the Schedule hereto should not be carried out on any part of the land described in Part II of the said Schedule unless permission therefor is granted upon an application duly made in that behalf:

NOW THEREFORE the said Committee in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1950 HEREBY DIRECT that the permission granted by Article 3 of the said Order shall not apply to the development specified in Part I of the Schedule hereto in any part of the land described in Part II of the said Schedule.

This Direction may be cited as the East Sussex (Fig. 2).

All those pieces on parcels of land situate at Fox's Farm Sheepstreet Lane in the parish of Etchingham comprising Ordnance Parcels Numbers 252 and 254 on the 1/2500 Ordnance Survey Sussex (East) Sheet XXX. 2 Edition of 1909 and more particularly delineated in the plan attached hereto and thereon coloured pink.
