COUNTY OF EAST SUSSEXTown and Country Planning General Development Order, 1963

WHEREAS the County Council of East Sussex, the local Planning Authority, are satisfied that it is expedient that the development specified in Part 1 of the Schedule hereto should not be carried out on any part of the land described in Part 11 of the said Schedule unless permission therefore is granted upon an application duly made in that behalf.

NOW THEREFORE the County Council in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1963, HEREBY DIRECT that the permission granted by Article 3 of the said Order shall not apply to the development specified in Part 1 of the Schedule hereto in any part of the land described in Part 11 of the said Schedule.

This Direction may be cited as The East Sussex (The Ridge, Winchelsea Beach) Direction, 1964.
