


Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1963.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING GENERAL DEVELOPMENT
ORDER, 1963

Whereas the East Sussex County Council, the local planning authority, are satisfied it is expedient that development of classes IV. 2, V, VI. 1 and 3, VII, VIII, XVII. C iii and D iii and XXII specified in Schedule 1 to the Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1963, should not be carried out within the area of land comprising Ordnance Parcel Nos. 97, 99b, 100, 101, 102, 103, 104, 105, 106, 106a, 107, 112, 112a, 113, 113a, 113b, 114, 115, 116, 117, 118, 118a, 119, 120, 121, 149, 150 in the Parish of Bodiam and shown coloured pink on the plan attached hereto, unless permission therefore is granted on an application duly made in that behalf;

Now therefore the County Council in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by Article 4 of the Town and County Planning General Development Order, 1963, hereby direct that the permission granted by Article 3 of the said Order shall not apply in the area shown on the said plan to the ~~said development of class VI or II. 3.~~

This Direction may be cited as the East Sussex (Bodiam Castle, Bodiam) Direction, 1968.
