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
TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING GENERAL DEVELOPMENT ORDER 1963

W H E R E A S the Mayor Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Bexhill (hereinafter referred to as the Bexhill Corporation) acting on behalf of the East Sussex County Council, the Local Planning Authority, are satisfied that it is expedient that development of classes II(1), IV(2), ~~VI(1)~~, VII, IX, and XXII specified in Schedule 1 to the Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1963, should not be carried out within the area of land at Normans Bay in the Borough of Bexhill shown edged red on the plan attached hereto (which said area of land comprises 26 acres or thereabouts and lies on the southern side of the railway line adjoining Normans Bay Halt) unless permission therefor is granted on an application duly made in that behalf;

NOW THEREFORE the Bexhill Corporation in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1963 HEREBY DIRECT that the permission granted by Article 3 of the said Order shall not apply in the area shown on the said plan to the said development.

This Direction may be cited as the Borough of Bexhill (Normans Bay No.2) Direction 1971.
