


#### COUNTY OF EAST SUSSEX

Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1950.

WHEREAS the County Planning Committee of the County Council of East Sussex, acting on behalf of the County Council as the Local Planning Authority for the said County, are satisfied that it is expedient that the development specified in Part I of the Schedule hereto should not be carried out on any part of the land described in Part II of the said Schedule unless permission therefor is granted upon an application duly made in that behalf:

NOW THEREFORE the said Committee in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1950 HEREBY DIRECT that the permission granted by Article 3 of the said Order shall not apply to the development specified in Part I of the Schedule hereto in any part of the land described in Part II of the said Schedule.

This Direction may be cited as the East Sussex (Brede) Direction, 1962.

#### The Schedule above referred to

#### Part I

- Class II.1. The erection or construction of gates, fences, walls or other means of enclosure not exceeding 4 feet in height where abutting on a road used by vehicular traffic or 7 feet in height in any other case, and the maintenance, improvement or other alteration of any gates, fences, walls or other means of enclosure being development comprised within Class II of the First Schedule to the Town and Country General Development Order 1950 (hereinafter referred to as "the Order") and not within any other Class.
  - Class IV.1. The erection or construction on land in, on, over or under which operations, other than mining operations, are being or about to be carried out in pursuance of planning permission granted or deemed to be granted under Part III of the Act, or on adjoining land, of buildings, works, plant or machinery needed temporarily in connection with those operations, for the period of such operations, being development comprised within Class IV of the First Schedule to the Order and not within any other Class.
  - caravan site on not more than 28 days in total in any calendar year, and the erection or placing of moveable structures on the land for the purposes of that use being development comprised within Class IV of the First Schedule to the Order and not within any other Class.
  - Class VI.1. The carrying out of building or engineering operations requisite for the use of the land for the purposes of agriculture being development comprised within Class VI of the First Schedule to the Order and not within any other Class.
  - Class VII. The carrying out of building and other operations (other than the provision or alteration of dwellings) requisite for the use of the land for the purposes of forestry (including afforestation) and the formation, alteration and maintenance of private ways on such land being development comprised within Class VII of the First Schedule to the Order and not within any other Class.

- Class IX. The carrying out of works required for the maintenance or improvement of an unadopted street or private way on land within the boundaries of the street or way being development comprised within Class IX of the First Schedule to the Order and not within any other Class.
- Class XXIII. The use of land, other than a building, as a caravan site in any of the circumstances specified in paragraphs 2 to 9 (inclusive) of the First Schedule to the Caravan Sites and Control of Development Act, 1960, or in the circumstances (other than those relating to winter quarters) specified in paragraph 10 of the said Schedule.

Land situate in the parish of Brede on the north side of the road leading from Battle to Rye (B.2089) comprising the greater part of Ordnance Parcel Number 54 on the Ordnance Survey Sussex (East) Sheet XLIV.12 (Edition of 1929) and shown edged pink on the plan attached hereto.
